# Replacing “Undisclosed”

- Undisclosed option will be replaced with the following options:
  - **Didn't Ask**
  - **Don't know**
  - **Prefer not to answer**
- If “Didn't Ask” is selected, upon reviewing the client's profile you will be asked to gather the data again
- Fields currently set to “Undisclosed” will be mapped to “Didn't Ask”

## Race and Hispanic Origin

White alone, percent

Black or African American alone, percent (a)

White alone, not Hispanic or Latino, percent

**White.** A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa. It includes people who indicate their race as "White" or report entries such as Irish, German, Italian, Lebanese, Arab, Moroccan, or Caucasian.

**Black or African American.** A person having origins in any of the Black racial groups of Africa. It includes people who indicate their race as "Black or African American," or report entries such as African American, Kenyan, Nigerian, or Haitian.

**American Indian and Alaska Native.** A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America) and who maintains tribal affiliation or community attachment. This category includes people who indicate their race as "American Indian or Alaska Native" or report entries such as Navajo, Blackfeet, Inupiat, Yup'ik, or Central American Indian groups or South American Indian groups.

**Asian.** A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam. This includes people who reported detailed Asian responses such as: "Asian Indian," "Chinese," "Filipino," "Korean," "Japanese," "Vietnamese," and "Other Asian" or provide other detailed Asian responses.

**Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander.** A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands. It includes people who reported their race as "Fijian," "Guamanian or Chamorro," "Marshallese," "Native Hawaiian," "Samoan," "Tongan," and "Other Pacific Islander" or provide other detailed Pacific Islander responses.

**Two or more races.** People may choose to provide two or more races either by checking two or more race response check boxes, by providing multiple responses, or by some combination of check boxes and other responses. For data product purposes, "Two or More Races" refers to combinations of two or more of the following race categories: "White," "Black or African American," American Indian or Alaska Native," "Asian," Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander," or "Some Other Race"

# Self Identify

- The self-identification field only pertains to military status
  - Are you or anyone in your household a veteran or on active duty?
    - Veteran
    - Active military
    - Didn't ask
    - Don't know
    - Prefer not to answer



# Disability

- The disability field will be tracked independently of “Self Identify”
  - Does somebody in your household have any disability?

- If the disability is currently being tracked in “Self Identify”, there will be a one-time migration to the new “Disability question”



# Monthly Income

- The new option will track the total household income instead of individual income
